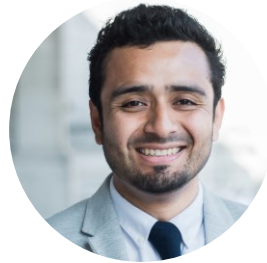

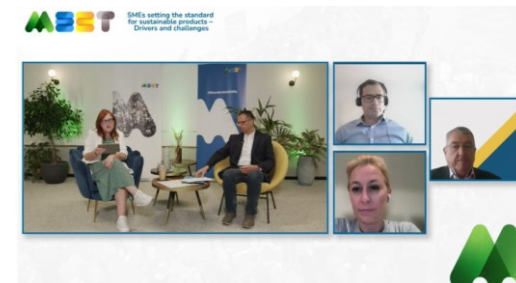

Europe's renovation wave risks exposing workers to asbestos

Labor unions are clashing with construction companies over how to protect workers from the carcinogen.

Industry's reality check

Business owners in the construction sector are sounding the alarm at the push from labor groups and the Parliament could hamper the EU efforts to renovate its building stock.

The stricter proposed limits risk making renovations "an extremely expensive procedure," said Fernando Sigchos of the **European Builders Confederation**, which represents SMEs in the construction sector. The equipment required to take such measurements is prohibitively expensive, he added. Properly isolating and disposing of asbestos, too, comes at a cost.

Sigchos argued the increased costs could lead to dodgy construction companies offering to take on those jobs for "half the price" and without the proper protections, undermining campaigners' efforts.

Alternatives

Alternative metrics do exist, however.

For a "coherent assessment" of (near) zero-emissions buildings, the **European Builders Confederation** proposes a combination of several measurements:

- Indoor environmental conditions
- The thermal characteristics of the building
- An accounting of heating, air conditioning and ventilation installed as well as a broader optimisation of the energy use of technical systems in the building
- Active renewable systems, and
- District or block heating and cooling systems

For Hamels though, a more straightforward approach is to measure the associated CO2 emissions of buildings. "They are what we should care about," the researcher said.

The European Construction Industry Federation (FIEC) and the European Federation of Building and Woodworkers (EFBBW), in cooperation with **European Builders Confederation** (EBC), has launched a Pact for Skills in Construction initiative.

The initiative is promoted by the European Commission in the framework of the "EU Skills Agenda".

The pact calls for concrete commitments to be made by construction and education stakeholders at all levels.

It aims at mobilising a concerted effort among private and public partners for quality investment in vocational education and training, as well as in knowledge.

The EU construction industry represents 9.5% of EU GDP (€1.324 billion) and 6.1% of EU total employment (12.7 million workers active in about 3.2 million enterprises).
